

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### What is the GMJGF?

The Graham Marsh Junior Golf Foundation, since its inception in 1979, has gained national prominence for the success of its junior golf development programmes.

The Foundation was designed to attract more young people into golf and to provide proper instruction and tournament experience for them. The programmes cater for the beginner and intermediate level juniors, under 18, to ensure not only future state players, but to give every boy and girl the opportunity to learn skills and have fun in the game of golf.

The major activities of the GMJGF are centred in three different areas:

### Coaching Activities

Through the Foundation's varied coaching programmes, boys and girls under 18 have access to golf instruction from experienced Professional Golf Association coaches at schools, country camps, clinics and the annual GMJGF Academy. Many of these programmes are conducted with assistance from golf clubs and District Golf Association personnel under the auspices of the WA Golf Association and Women's Golf WA.

In addition to catering for juniors at beginner and intermediate level, programmes have been introduced for advanced instruction and ultimately these juniors have the chance to represent WA in national competitions.

### Tournament Activities

Through the GMJGF tournament programme, boys and girls under 18 are encouraged to enter events, whether they be members of golf clubs affiliated with the WA Golf Association or they play their golf at a public course.

During 1981 the Foundation inaugurated a stroke averages contest for junior golfers in six age categories to enable the young players to gauge their

performances against other juniors. The contest concludes in

November each year. Trophies are presented to age division winners at the Tournament of Champions.

One of the goals of the GMJGF has been to upgrade the calibre of junior golf events available to juniors in WA. Through the Foundation's tournament activities this goal is being met.

### Information Services

Another main goal of the Foundation is to work closely with the WA Golf Association Junior Council, affiliated golf clubs throughout WA, Women's Golf WA, public golf course controllers, the Department of Education, the Department of Sport and Recreation, Healthway and the Heart Foundation to establish a clearing house for junior golf and junior golfers. Much progress has been made in this area.

The GMJGF newsletter was commenced in April 1982 providing members with information about camps, coaching and tournament activities, schedules, entry procedure and other information of interest to the junior golfer.

The Foundation invites all junior golfers and other interested individuals to be part of the Graham Marsh Junior Golf Foundation through your membership.
